

# LABORERS

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## DESCRIPTION

Work performed by the Laborers covers 109 separate classifications of individual worker duties and responsibilities in areas as challenging and diverse as Heavy Highway, Tunnel Boring, Residential, Heavy Building, Hazardous Materials Handling and Abatement, Drilling, Blasting, Concrete Placement, Coring and Sawing, Pipe Laying, Grade Checking and Traffic Control Supervision, to name a few.

## APPRENTICESHIP & TRAINING PROGRAMS

The Laborer Apprenticeship Program provides continuing work opportunities for eligible candidates who are at least 18 years of age and possess a minimum of ten years academic schooling or equivalency. Apprentices are required to attend and successfully complete at least 144 hours per year of formal education classes throughout the year, available at multiple facilities while they are working in the construction field. To complete the program each participant must satisfactorily complete 4,000 hours of on-the-job training, and meet attendance and performance goals.
